## Educating to a Higher Standard

### FOR CATHOLIC STUDENTS

The tuition rate for Catholic students who are supported by participation in a local Catholic parish is \$5900\*\* for the 2010 – 2011 academic year. Automatic discounts are given for Vo-tech students and siblings attending Holy Name High School.

### FOR NON-CATHOLIC

The tuition rate for Non-Catholic students and International Students is \$6300 for the 2010-2011 academic year. Automatic discounts are given for Vo-tech students and siblings attending Holy Name.

### FOR ALL STUDENTS

Each student will be assessed an additional \$1150 school fee to offset the cost of school activities and will receive a pass to all home athletic events.

Students who wish to participate in the Magazine Drive will be given a discount of 40% of the total value of magazines sold during the drive. The discount will be given throughout the second semester.

All students will be assessed a \$100 registration fee payable at the time of registration/re-enrollment.

### PAYMENT OPTIONS

1. Families that pay tuition and school fee in full by July 15, 2010 will receive a 2% rebate check to be sent on August 15, 2010 (no discount will be given for payments received after July 15, 2009).
2. Families that do not wish to pay in full must utilize the FACTS Tuition Payment Program for monthly payments of tuition and school fee.

### Requests for Financial Aid

FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment provides financial need analysis for Holy Name High School. Families applying for financial aid must complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS by **March 15, 2010**. Families can apply on-line at [www.factstuitionaid.com](http://www.factstuitionaid.com). The following information is required in order to process your application:

- Completed application
- \$25 Application fee
- Copies of 2008 or 2009 tax form including all supporting tax schedules
- Copies of your 2009 W-2 form from both parents
- Copies of supporting documentation for SSI, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers Compensation and TANF

Please note: Late or incomplete applications will result in reduced or no financial aid.
